DUTIES: Under the direction of the State/Assistant State Medical Examiner, the Assistant Medical Examiner shall conduct autopsies and external examinations for the purpose of determining the cause and manner of death, and provide expert testimony in court proceedings as necessary. Educational responsibilities include providing instruction to law enforcement officers, medicolegal investigators, medical students and residents. The successful candidate may be required to attend various committees, meetings, or seminars. Each medical examiner will be responsible for less than 200 autopsies per year; performs other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS
