DUTIES: Under the direction of the State Superintendent or the Deputy State Superintendent of the Office of Weights and Measures, Division of Consumer Affairs, Department of Law and Public Safety, has charge of and supervises the enforcement program pursuant to (N.J.S.A. Title 51, N.J.S.A. 4:9-11 and N.J.A.C. Title 13) of the State Office; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Six years of experience in weights and measures inspection and investigative enforcement; two years of which shall have included supervisory experience.

Thirty semester hours of college level study in the fields of engineering, physics, electronics, mathematics or statistical methods may be substituted for the required non-supervisory experience on a year for year basis, up to and including the first three years.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is required to perform the essential duties of the position.
