**DUTIES:** Under the direction of the Engineer in Charge of Maintenance or other supervisory official at the New Jersey Training School, performs varied types of plumbing work involved in the installation, repair, and maintenance of plumbing and steamfitting fixtures, fittings, and systems; performs other related duties as required.

**REQUIREMENTS**

**EXPERIENCE:** Three (3) years of broad experience in work involving the installation, inspection, repair, and maintenance of plumbing and steamfitting fixtures, fittings appliances, machinery, and plumbing systems.

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Appointment to this title will be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open-competitive examination. If selected for the position, you must apply for the open-competitive examination, when issued by the Civil Service Commission, pass and be reachable on the resulting eligible list to be permanently appointed to the title.
