DUTIES: Under the supervision of the Assistant Attorney General of the Affirmative Civil Enforcement Practice Group in Newark, provides counsel and representation regarding Data Privacy & Cybersecurity matters; will oversee the Section; plans and manages the supervision and operations of the Section; assigns matters and supervises all Deputy Attorneys General in the Section; evaluates the performance of assigned Deputy Attorneys General; conducts case file reviews; performs other duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an Attorney-at-Law in the State of New Jersey required.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience as a practicing attorney, two (2) years of which shall have been in a supervisory capacity.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to candidates who have relevant experience in areas of state and federal internet privacy and data protection laws and regulations, including the N.J. Consumer Fraud Act, the Computer Related Offenses Act, the federal Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
