DUTIES: Under the direction of a supervisory officer at the Juvenile Medium Security Facility, does the field and office work involved in conducting varied types of social investigations involving the collection, analysis, and recording of significant social facts, drawing sound conclusions, and basing appropriate action thereon; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience in social case work, which shall have included the responsibility for gathering and analyzing social information from clients, the determination of their needs, and the planning and administration of treatment plans geared toward the needs of individual clients.

NOTE: A Bachelor's degree in Social Work including or supplemented by a supervised field placement accredited by the Council on Social Work Education may be substituted for the above stated education and experience requirements.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year for year basis.

NOTE: Possession of a Master's degree in Social Work from an accredited college or university may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in NJ only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determination will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
