DUTIES: Under close supervision of a supervisory official in the Communications Support Unit, Emergency Management Section, Division of State Police will perform entry-level tasks including, but not limited to, installing, testing, set-up (configurations), troubleshooting and repairing data and voice communication network hardware systems of various peripheral devices and wiring systems associated with minicomputer, microcomputer or mainframe computer-based systems, Local Area Networks (LANs), and multi-line telephone systems and equipment; performs other related duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Completion of a vocational, technical, or specialized training program in computer technology, electrical technology, electronic technology, electronic engineering technology, computer operations, or data processing.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience in work involving the installation, maintenance, troubleshooting and repair of electrical or electronic components, equipment or systems, which shall have included one (1) year pertaining to data and voice communications network hardware, related peripheral devices, and associated wiring systems.

SUBSTITUTIONS: An Associate's Degree (or 60 college credits) from an accredited college in computer technology, electrical technology, electronic technology, electronic engineering technology, telecommunications, data processing, or closely allied field may be substituted for the required education and one (1) year of nonsupervisory experience.

Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute one (1) year of additional nonsupervisory experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: Appointment to this title may be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open-competitive examination (PAOC). If selected for the position and appointed PAOC, you must apply for the open-competitive examination for this title when issued by the Civil Service Commission, pass and be reachable on the resulting eligible list to be permanently appointed to the title.

RESUME NOTE: Eligibility determinations will be based upon information presented in resume only. Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so will result in your ineligibility.
