**DUTIES:** Under the direction of a Deputy Director, Deputy Attorney General 1, or other supervisory official, represents the Division of Gaming Enforcement as prescribed by applicable statutes; handles and assists with investigations of and proceedings relating to casino entities, other affiliated entities, individual qualifiers and casino employees; conducts work related to the investigation of casino matters and prosecution of regulatory violations, drafts administrative actions for statutory and/or regulatory violations; interprets and enforces law and regulations; as the Attorney General's representative, participates in legal and related activities involving cases in federal, county and local jurisdictions and before other State entities; prepares petition responses and Division orders; conducts legal research; drafts regulatory provisions; performs other duties as assigned.

**REQUIREMENTS**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited law school with a Juris Doctor. Admission to practice as an attorney-at-law in the State of New Jersey required.

**EXPERIENCE:** Two (2) years of experience as a practicing attorney.

**NOTE:** Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey since the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
